SUMMARY OF SERVICES

The Mental Health Center of Greater Manchester is a private, non-profit system of comprehensive mental health services that, for 62 years, has been available to Manchester area citizens in need of care. This past year we served 11,227 community members.

We are a designated community mental health program for Region VII (Greater Manchester) by the NH Bureau of Behavioral Health. In that capacity, we provide a broad range of evidence-based services to people with serious and/or persistent mental illness. 49% of our individuals, or 5,488, meet that criteria. We also operate an affiliate group practice, Bedford Counseling Associates, to serve persons not eligible for those services.

We have a staff of more than 480, who operate over 35 programs and provide 24/7 emergency psychiatric response to the community. We are the largest provider of outpatient mental health services in New Hampshire, and we are affiliated with Dartmouth Medical School.

CLIENTS SERVED AND SERVICES PROVIDED 2021–2022

Over this past year the Center provided treatment services to 11,227 people from the greater Manchester area. Of those 49% or 5,488 individuals were individuals diagnosed with one or more severe mental illnesses. These individuals were served in the Center's community-based system of care. With the event of the COVID-19 Pandemic, MHCGM transitioned to providing most services via telehealth. It is believed that this is the major reason we were able to see and provide more services than the previous year.


